



Mid-America Shutter Painting Procedures

Painting your Mid-America shutters can easily be accomplished by following these simple Sherwin-Williams procedures. Mid-America accepts no responsibility regarding the finished results obtained by painting it's shutters. Any and all painting questions should be directed to Sherwin-Williams.

Mid-America's SolidThru™ Color Shutters have a 40-year warranty against cracking, fading or splitting. If these shutters are painted the warranty is voided.

Paintable Shutter: Polystyrene

This model is ready for paint with minimal prep required.

1. Wash off grease and oils with a solution of household detergent and water.
Rinse thoroughly.
2. Dry surface completely before apply Sherwin-Williams paints.
3. Directly apply Sherwin-Williams Duration™ or SuperPaint™ to the shutter.
A primer is not necessary for this shutter.

SolidThru™ Color Shutter: Polypropylene

Due to the properties associated with polypropylene, paint will experience a significant loss of adhesion when applied to these shutters. Therefore, we **do not** recommend painting SolidThru™ Color Shutters.
